-Pitching Distance:

High School going to 3 feet more, Daryl things good thing for senior league, as far as intermediate 35 too close move to 40, intermediate start at 40 not 35.

Suggesting no more optional moving of the pitchers mount?? Minor will go to 32. If you move one league, every league needs to be moved.

Substitution for pitching – some feel coaches manipulate their when the pitcher comes in and then out and back in. Some have pitchers face top of the order, bring her out for bottom, and then back in for top.

Asked if each team has at least 1 pitcher on the team, however x amount of pitchers and teams should use 3 pitchers.
